CHAPTER 3



HDB BRANDING

Background and need of the program

The need for a new hospital building was evident due to various compelling reasons. Firstly, the existing 200-bed facility operated at full capacity, resulting in the rejection of approximately 7.000-8.000 patients annually who were then redirected to other hospitals for treatment. Secondly, the absence of cancer radiation therapy services at the current facility necessitated the referral of patients to other hospitals with which tie-ups were established. Additionally, despite more than 45,000 cases of cataracts reported annually, only 28,000-30,000 surgeries were performed, emphasizing the urgent need to address the increasing demand for cataract treatment. Moreover, the hospital's proximity to a highway led to frequent emergency and casualty cases, highlighting the pressing need to expand and enhance healthcare facilities to effectively cater to the community's needs.

Objectives of the Study



Construct establish and operate a 45bed in-patient ward equipped with medical instruments and necessary infrastructure, in an upcoming startof-art, multi-speciality hospital adjacent to an existing 200-bed facility on the Hospital compound at Srishti Complex in Mira Road Thane



Provide holistic and quality medical care to indigent patients at the newly constructed annexure hospital building at affordable rates and free treatment for indigent patients.

CHAPTER 4 RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

HDB Financial Services Ltd commissioned SoulAce to conduct an impact assessment study to evaluate the immediate and enduring impact of the program implemented under the Infrastructure and Procurement of Medical Equipment-based CSR theme. The impact assessment study was conducted in FY 2023-24 fiscal year.

Objectives of the study



To assess the immediate and enduring impacts of the healthcare program.



To evaluate the program's effectiveness, efficiency, and sustainability in addressing critical healthcare needs within the community.



o measure the quality of healthcare services provided by the hospital.



To gauge the level of community engagement and inclusivity within the program.



To identify areas for improvement to enhance the program's overall impact and sustainability.

Definition of Research

Research can be stated as a logical and systematic search for new and useful information on a particular subject matter, locial science research refers to the systematic citivity of gaining new understanding by oliowing scientific principles and methods to minimize bias and subjectivity. It is contrary to virting something based on assumptions or peculations. Though information on certain facts can also be gained through common sense and based on general observation and hearsay, those facts will prevent the considered valid until they have been obtained in a methodical manner, which can stand the test of time. The defining heracteristics of scientific research are objectivity, ethical neutrality, reliability testability, and transparency. The identification of the research problem provides the starting point of research, which is then defined and redefined through a proper review of the literature on the problem of deliberations with treasured the problem of the subject matter of interest. Each research problem has a multitude of perspectives and dimensions, and research cannot cover all of those in a single study. Thus, we need to delimit the research problem into a 'measurable problem and formulate objectives, make decisions on the research design, sample design, type of research instruments for collecting the data, and how these data can be edited, coded, classified, tabulated, and interpreted so that findings and conclusions can be reached. Every research needs to have a proper methodology to foresee the problems that could arise in the process and steer through it in a proper direction without losing focus.

Use of Mixed Methodology for maximum insights

The research problem pertained to assessing the impact of this initiative on local communities. The project's success lies in recognizing the pressing need for integrated solutions that holistically serve humanity by providing affordable and quality health care and by offering free and concessional medical treatment to the peeds vections of society.

Application of Quantitative

Techniques

A quantitative study is needed when the focus is on presenting the study problem in terms of numbers, frequencies, percentages, etc. In quantitative research, standardized instruments such as questionnaires and interview schedules are employed to collect data. Though the information obtained is easily amenable to various statistical measures and tests, quantitative information has its limitations. It can uncover only the surface phenomena. It is unable to penetrate beneath the surface and identify what is hidden. In this study, structured tools like the interview schedule administered were used to assess the impact. This helped in obtaining quantifiable information.

Application of Qualitative Techniques

Qualitative research can only unravel enriched and hidden information that may not be evident on the face of it. The qualitative approach is distinguished by deeper probing and flexibility, and it can yield massive amounts of data that were not anticipated when the research was initiated. Quantitative techniques were used for better accuracy, to ensure anonymity, and, at the same time, to cover a larger sample population. Qualitative techniques of interviews with key stakeholders and interviews with community people were adopted for a better understanding of the problem alongside quantitative research.

Project Evaluation Framework

After the collection of relevant information and perceptions through interviews, the OECD framework would be followed/applied. It has six evaluation criteria - relevance, coherence, efficiency, effectiveness, impact, sustainability for each of the indicators.



Ensuring Triangulation

Triangulation was needed to increase the credibility and validity of the research findings. It was also a measure taken to ensure the trustworthiness of the research process. The findings of the quantitative research have been verified with the insights from qualitative research, and the report has also been structured to reflect this point.

Study Tools

SoulAce has developed a mobile application platform for quantitative data collection. The field team used this app to undertake the study. This application has real-time data entry and data upload features with CPS location details along with a questionnaire for interaction with the project beneficiaries; the application has a provision to take pictures of each respondent.

Primary data was collected using two types of questionnaires.



Questionnaire for Primary Beneficiaries:

Structured questionnaires were developed, the project details for each of the focus areas were reviewed, and indicators were predefined before conducting the surveys.



Questionnaire for Secondary Beneficiaries and Stakeholders: Semi-structured questionnaires were developed for each type of sample of this group. Stakeholders were

identified across the focus areas.

One-on-one discussions were done with beneficiaries to prepare case studies.

Ensuring Commitment to Research Ethics



Anonymity

Anonymity refers to not revealing the identity of the respondents. This research study strictly sticks to not revealing the identity of respondents unless the same is warranted for the illustration of success stories or case studies. After the research was completed, the study did not reveal which individual respondents answered which question in what manner. The results were revealed only as an aggregate, so no one could single out a particular respondent's identity. This was required to not break the respondent's trust by not revealing the individual identity.



Confidentiality

Research subjects participate in the process only based on the trust that confidentiality is maintained. Hence, the research would not reveal any data regarding the respondents for purposes other than the research study.



Non-Maleficence

Research would not lead to harm to the research subjects. This study ensured that the respondents were not harmed in any way.



Beneficence

Any research study should lead to some benefits for the respondent. This research study also ensures that individuals, groups, and communities benefit and enhance their well-being.



Justice

Justice refers to being fair to all. This research study ensures equal treatment of all its research subjects and no biases or prejudices towards any group based on social stereotypes or stigma associated with being a member of a certain group or class.

CHAPTER 5

KEY STUDY FINDINGS AND IMPACT

The chapter explores the partnership between HDB Financial Services Ltd and Shri Chaitanya Health and Care Trust, focusing on the infrastructure support provided to enhance medical care for indigent patients. The hospital's holistic healthcare program aimed to address diverse needs while promoting community engagement and inclusivity. Key project activities included implementing comprehensive healthcare services, conducting maintenance checks, and offering specialized treatments like eye care and cancer screening. The study evaluates the impact of this program on community health, emphasizing effectiveness, accessibility, and inclusivity. It also discusses the project's alignment with Sustainable Development Goals and its significance in addressing local healthcare challenges. Additionally, the chapter highlights stakeholder engagement, impact assessment methodologies, and recommendations for further enhancing the program's sustainability and outreach efforts.

Outreach and inclusivity

People from marginalized communities with different kinds of ailments, including cancer care and other critical health conditions.

Demography of beneficiary population

The qualitative survey revealed that the beneficiaries of the Shri Chaitanya Health and Care Trust program encompassed a diverse demographic profile. Coming from both urban and semi-urban communities, the age range of the beneficiaries spanned from young adults to middle-aged individuals, with a notable representation in the 18-55 age group. Occupationally, beneficiaries included both salaried employees and individuals engaged in small-term businesses that reflected a broad spectrum of socio-economic backgrounds. Family sizes typically ranged from 4 to 6 members, while the average monthly income of their households fell within the range of Rs 10.001-15.000. Overall, this demographic analysis portrayed a diverse beneficiary population that benefitted from the hospital program's services.



6. Pre-Intervention



HIGH PATIENT VOLUME

The hospital's previous 200-bed facility operated at full capacity, resulting in the rejection of approximately 7000-8000 patients annually due to limited bed availability. This indicated a significant demand for healthcare services in the area, leading to longer wait times and reduced accessibility to medical care for some patients.



LACK OF SPECIALIZED SERVICES

The absence of cancer radiation therapy services at the previous facility necessitated redirecting patients needing such treatment to other hospitals with which tie-ups were established. This created inconvenience and added logistical challenges for patients needing specialized cancer care within the hospital's premises.



UNMET DEMAND FOR CATARACT SURGERIES

Despite a notable prevalence of cataract cases in the community, only a fraction of affected individuals (28,000-30,000 out of 45,000) received surgical intervention annually at the previous facility. This highlighted a disparity between the demand for cataract surgeries and the facility's capacity to meet it, emphasising the need for expanded surgical services or enhanced collaboration with other healthcare providers to address this gap effectively.



HIGH INCIDENCE OF EMERGENCY CASES

Situated near a highway, the hospital previously experienced a frequent influx of emergency and casualty cases, which reflected a high occurrence of accidents or medical emergencies in the surrounding area. This underscored the hospital's pivotal role as a frontline healthcare provider to address acute healthcare needs within the community.



PATIENT EXPERIENCE

Patients have faced challenges related to the quality of care, amenities, and overall patient experience, which have impacted their satisfaction and well-being during their healthcare journey.



COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

There have been limited community engagement initiatives, awareness programs, and outreach activities, which have resulted in lower community health literacy and preventive healthcare practices.

7. Key Program Inputs and Activities



COMPREHENSIVE HEALTHCARE SERVICES IMPLEMENTATION

- Provision of primary medical care, specialized treatments, surgical interventions, and emergency care was implemented.

Subsequently, the study showed that the quick turnaround time to address suses, with all respondents reporting a response time of less than 6 hours, indicates a proactive approach to problem-solving within the hospital. This efficiency in addressing issues promptly is likely to contribute to smoother operations and better patient outcomes.
